PRAYING AS FAMILIES

The Annual Day of Prayer for Children at High Risk is a call to pray for the vulnerable children of the world and those who minister among them. The theme for 2017 is Compassion and the Working Child. It is a call that recognizes that the need is so enormous that only God is sufficient to meet that need.

Oakseed Ministries encourages families to invite 2 or 3 other families to come together in a home on Sunday afternoon, June 11th to pray together. It is an opportunity for parents, children, and grandparents to come together because of a great need—Compassion and the Working Child.

How to make it happen.

1. Decide as a family what other families you want to invite to your home.
2. Send an invitation and then phone the invited families to share with them what this is all about.
3. Let your potential guests know what to expect:
 - An informal time of prayer directed by a printed outline.
 - Some selected Bible passages will be read.
 - Even young children will feel comfortable.
 - It will last for just one hour.
 - There will be refreshments afterwards.
