PRAYING AS FAMILIES

The Annual Day of Prayer for Children at High Risk is a call to pray for the vulnerable children of the world and those who minister among them. The theme for 2018 is The Lost and Forgotten Child. This call recognizes the great need for children around the world, as well as the truth embedded in Matthew 18, that the Lord seeks out the lost and forgotten.

Oakseed Ministries encourages families to invite 2 or 3 other families to come together in a home on Sunday afternoon, June 10th to pray together. Parents, children, and grandparents coming together to remember, and pray for, the lost and forgotten child.

How to make it happen.

1. Decide as a family what who you want to invite to your home.
2. Send an invitation
3. Speak with the invited families to share what this is all about.
 - An informal time of prayer following an outline.
 - Some pre-selected Bible passages will be read.
 - Specific points of engagement for young children.
 - It will last for just one hour.
 - There will be refreshments afterwards.
